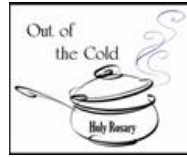

OUT OF THE COLD



The program will start on **Saturday, November 17th** this year. *Out of the Cold Holy Rosary* is a breakfast and lunch program that feeds the poor and homeless and runs each **Saturday (8 a.m. to 2 p.m.) from November to**

April in the Parish Centre. Please pray for the program as we start up and please consider one of the following volunteer positions:

Student Volunteer: There are 2 major shifts available: 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. and 12 p.m. to 2 p.m.

Home Cooks: They prepare the main dish each week at home and drop it off any time on Saturday morning. They make enough for 12 portions. You are called on to do this a maximum of twice a month, and we give you the dates and dish a month in advance.

Kitchen team: Help in the kitchen on Saturday (there are 2 major shifts available: 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. and 12 p.m. to 2 p.m.) to prepare the side dishes (soup, salad, breakfast, etc., for 100), serve the meal and clean up afterwards.

Opportunities: We are in definite need of **male volunteers** for the 12 p.m. to 2 p.m. shift, and are specifically looking for assistance in the washing/drying of dishes. We are also in need of the **weekly washing of the linens** (approx. 3 loads). They can be picked up on the designated Saturday afternoons (around 1 p.m.) and returned the following week (Friday/Saturday morning).

Lastly, for all those who wish to help us build our funds for this year's program, **donations** can be made at the parish office or by placing the donation in the basket at Mass each week. Please mark cash envelopes "*Out of the Cold*". Cheques are made out to "*Holy Rosary*" but please mark "*Out of the Cold*" in the memo section. This parish program does not take City money; we survive **100% on parishioner donations.**

This year's coordinators are comprised of six individuals: Elena Mascarenhas (Central Coordinator), Rose Weesbach (Treasurer), Ewa Chichewicz (Kitchen Team Coordinator), Jackie Jenson and Linda Russell (Home Cook Coordinator), Angie San Juan (Food Shopper). We would like to thank Roshelle Rivera for joining the team as the Student Volunteer Coordinator and Angeli San Juan for assisting in food shopping.

2007 WORLD MISSION SUNDAY



World Mission Sunday, organized by the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, is a day set aside for Catholics worldwide to recommit themselves to the Church's missionary activity through prayer and sacrifice.

As described by Pope John Paul II, World Mission Sunday is "an important day in the life of the Church because it teaches how to give: as an offering made to God, in the Eucharistic celebration and for all the missions of the world" (see Redemptoris Missio 81).

Most Reverend, *Richard J. Grecco, Auxiliary Bishop of Toronto*: "Today, the Catholic Church around the world will observe World Mission Sunday. This annual observance was instituted 80 years ago in 1926 by a papal decree issued by Pope Pius XI. Funds collected are made available to the **Universal Solidarity Fund**, and they look after the distribution of these **Pontifical Society** funds to the young churches in mission lands, especially the poorest. Pope Benedict XVI in his message for World Mission Sunday 2007 has selected 'All the Churches for all the World' as the theme for this year's World Mission Sunday, 21 October 2007. World Mission Sunday truly belongs to the whole world. It is celebrated in every country, in every diocese, in every parish, even the poorest. Let us be part of this great act of solidarity in prayer, in sacrifice and in generous giving."

This Sunday there will be a Second Collection.
