LETTERS OF REFERENCE

If you foresee that you will need a Letter of Reference from a priest any time in the future, it is absolutely essential that you introduce yourself to the priest well in advance so that he gets to know you. In Catholic tradition, a Letter of Reference is meant to prove that a person is a "practising Catholic" – one who regularly attends Sunday Mass with the parish community. A priest who does not have some acquaintance with a person cannot satisfy such a request. If you foresee that you will be invited to be a godparent at Baptism, a sponsor at Confirmation or intend to apply for a position to teach in a Catholic school, introduce yourself to one of the parish priests on staff, visit him periodically as you leave Mass and become active in some parish activity. Another proof of regular attendance at Sunday Mass is by using offertory envelopes and regularly contributing to the offertory collection. It is presumed that you are registered in the parish and that your name is on the parish list. There are many signs of "belonging to the church," and a priest needs at least one piece of evidence before he can put his signature to a Letter of Reference.
