30TH ANNUAL CARDINAL'S DINNER **THURSDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2009**

This is the largest annual dinner in Canada and to date has raised over \$6 million for the Archbishop's personal charities – charities for the less fortunate that are not fully funded by structured agencies. The event will take place at the Metro Toronto Convention Centre. The cost is \$175 per person or \$1,750 for a table to ten. Please call the Parish Office to reserve your ticket.

The dinner was begun in 1979 by the late Cardinal Gerald Emmett Carter and has been run in recent years by Carter's successors, Cardinal Aloysius Ambrozic and Collins, with proceeds going to their favourite charities.
