BROTHER LAWRENCE SPITZIG

Renowned teacher Datuk Brother Lawrence Spitzig has passed away in Kuala Lumpur last week at the age of 91. The Canadian's first assignment was at St Joseph's Institute in Singapore in 1938 at the age of 19. He was transferred to St John's during World War II in 1941. At the age of 20, he was sent to Pudu Prison and later was a prisoner of war at Changi, Singapore during World War II. He was conferred the Datukship award by the Yang Di-Pertuan Agong for his service in February. In 1954, he was made principal of St John's, then at St Xavier's before going to La Salle Petaling Jaya. Brother Spitzig was awarded the Order of Canada in 2004.
