In addition to general recommendations from the health officials, I would ask everyone to be attentive to some particular points relating to our celebration of the liturgy.

- **Eucharistic Ministers** will use a hand sanitizer immediately before distributing Holy Communion.
- The faithful should be instructed that, **if they feel ill, have a fever, or have recently been sick, they should not receive Holy Communion on the tongue or from the cup.** Of course, if they are ill, they should stay home.
- **The Sign of Peace** is an important part of our liturgical celebration. The custom is to express the Sign of Peace by shaking hands. It may, however, be preferable in the present circumstances to use another gesture, such as bowing or saying "Peace be with you."
