Each year in the Catholic community, there are hundreds of children that need to leave their family home and be placed in foster care. At any given time, more than 1,100 children and youth are unable to live with their parents owing to parental illness, abandonment, child abuse or neglect. The Catholic Children's Aid Society of Toronto depends on loving foster families to provide safe and nurturing homes for these vulnerable children and youth.

Sadly, there are not enough foster homes to accommodate these children in the Greater Toronto Area. In the words of Archbishop Thomas Collins: *"I strongly believe that more Catholic families would be open to caring for foster children if they were aware of this urgent need for foster homes. I am inviting you seriously to consider fostering, and to reflect on the benefits the experience can bring to your family and vulnerable children in the community."*

The Catholic Children's Aid Society continues to work with parishes to recruit foster homes through its **Let a Child Have Faith in You** campaign. In 2000, the Bishop of Lafayette, Louisiana, banned the short stories and novels of Flannery O'Connor from the schools of his diocese. She would have been highly amused at the spectacle of a bishop proscribing works that are imbued with Catholicism from beginning to end. Even during her short life—she died in 1964 at the age of thirty-nine—she was recognized as the leading Catholic writer of her generation, or any other for that matter.
