The final donations have been sent to the HIV/AIDS orphans and patients for the year and we continue to look forward to 2010. We are currently working toward the 2010 Orphan Sponsorship renewal on the first Sunday of Advent. We hope to deliver updated pictures and stories of the orphans for our existing sponsors and hope to find new sponsors wishing to enter the project. Within Embulbul, Fr. Fabian, who has travelled from Kenya to visit us twice, has been named the Head of Kenya for the Society of African Missions, and Fr. Reginald has taken over day-to-day operations of the parish. Fr.
