Dear Parishioners:

Last Sunday, June 6, 2010, the Feast of Corpus Christi, we held our parish's Annual General Meeting. About fifty parishioners attended.

Regarding maintenance: the church's confessional room (baptistry) is in need of major repairs, which will be made in the coming months. Also the doors to the Marian entrance and the wheelchair-accessible entrance will be restored and varnished this summer.

Extensively canvassed was the future of Holy Rosary Parish Hall. Generally, participants were open to re-developing the site. The Parish Hall Committee will engage Mr. Tom Payne of KPMB Architects to conduct a feasibility study. On the understanding that the hall will not be demolished for several years, minimal upkeep and repair will be required. There will be periodic updates on the feasibility study and the involvement of the Toronto District Catholic School Board (TDCSB) and Holy Rosary School. A copy of the minutes of the meeting is available upon request.

To help finance church repairs, we will be having a 50-50 draw in the fall; other fundraising events will take place from time to time.

I offer special thanks to Mimi Allemand, Helen Duhaime, and Patricia Griffith of the Special Event Committee for setting up and decorating the gym. We also express gratitude to Development & Peace, especially Sharon Corcoran, for providing coffee and muffins. Finally, we appreciate the generosity of the 400 Walmer Road Tenants Association for donating bottled water and iced tea. May God bless you.
