Dear Parishioners:

I invite you to join me in thanking Lindsay Moore, our Pastoral Associate, for her contributions in the life of Holy Rosary Parish for the past two years. She has resigned recently from her position in order to pursue her career at the Ottawa School Board. On behalf of the parish, I thank her for dedication and hard work in ministering to the youth. I wish her well and success in her future endeavours.

I also take this opportunity to update you on the re-development project at the parish hall. The Parish Hall Committee, the Archdiocese of Toronto, and the Toronto Catholic District School Board met with Mr. Tom Payne, of KPMB, on July 15, 2010 at the parish. We are moving forward to conduct a feasibility study on both the parish hall site and the school site. The report is expected to be finished by the end of September this year.

The work of stabilizing the baptistry (the west side of the church attachment) is continuing. The finishing time has been delayed and is expected to be completed by the end of August. Meanwhile, the repair of the Marian entrance doors is almost completed and access to the church will be resumed as soon as the walkway is cleared by the end of August. Also, the handicapped entrance (the North East church entrance) will be blocked off on August 5th because the set of doors will be repaired. A temporary ramp will be set up at the South East entrance during the period for public access. The front door will be left open during the day from Monday to Saturday. I am sorry for the inconvenience this might cause for those who rely on these entrances.

**SEMI-ANNUAL REPORT FROM THE
FINANCE COUNCIL TO THE PARISHIONERS OF
HOLY ROSARY CHURCH**

Included in the bulletin is a summary of operations for the operating fund and the capital and maintenance fund for the six month period ended June 30, 2010.

The Council would like to take this opportunity to thank each and every one of you for your generosity in supporting the parish.

You will note from the operating fund statement that the offertory continues to decline. To date, the offertory is lower by \$7,060. This seems to be a continuing trend and it is of a major concern as the offertory is our main source of operating funds. Fortunately because of various other activities such as rental of the parish hall, fees from weddings, baptisms and funerals, we have a small net surplus for the period of \$7,094 although we've had an operating deficit of \$57,118 for the period. The Council has also provided you with a statement of operations for the capital and maintenance fund for the six month period. At the annual general meeting held in June, a parishioner had raised a concern relating to the Diocesan Assessment. In the statement it appears that the assessment is higher than last year, even though the offertory is lower. The diocesan assessment has not increased but the calculation is six months in arrears, and the amount reported for the June 30, 2010 period relates to the net offertory from the last six months of 2009.

As you will note, we have an operating surplus for the period. However, as you can see, we are in the process of doing major renovations to the baptistry at a cost of approximately \$70,000. We are also in the process of resurfacing and repairing the church doors.

The church is aging and will be in need of major repairs, starting this year and probably continuing over the next couple of years. We need your continued support to fund the many programs delivered by the parish and will require further assistance with our upcoming capital and maintenance projects. The Finance Council is asking all parishioners to make use of their yellow capital and maintenance funds envelopes to help the parish with funding the cost of the major repairs. Please use these envelopes each month and we ask you to try to increase your contribution to the capital and maintenance fund to help pay for the cost of these large repairs. Again we thank you all for your continued support and generosity.
